Aims of Moulton Pre-school.

- 1. To provide high quality, affordable and accessible childcare to children from ages 2 to 5 years.
- 2. To provide a caring, fun and affordable before & after School club for children at the pre-school and those who attend Moulton school.
- 3. To work in partnership with parents and carers to ensure equal opportunities are offered to all children and their families.
- 4. To give the children the opportunity to socialise with other children and adults in a safe, supportive and stimulating environment.
- 5. To help our children grow in confidence to reach their full potential.
- 6. To provide a setting in which children can develop their physical, emotional, social, intellectual and creative skills.
- 7. To support children's different preferences, learning styles, needs and interests.
- 8. To promote a healthy lifestyle through exercise, nutritional knowledge and building a sound foundation for well-being.
- 9. To provide an outdoor curriculum to enable children to experience learning in a natural environment.

Our objective is to provide all this and more in which the children can feel happy and at home to enable them to fulfil their individual potential.

Organisation of Moulton Preschool

Moulton Preschool is a registered charity and is run by an elected Committee which ensures the major decisions are in the hands of the parents who use the group. An Annual General meeting is held yearly in the autumn term. The Committee employ qualified staff members who are in charge of the day to day running of the group and deliver the education and care of the children daily.

A high adult: child ratio is essential in providing good quality Preschool care. We have a 1:8 ratio for children aged 3 – 5 years, and a 1:4 ratio, for children under the age of 3 years.

All staff attend regular meetings to undertake curriculum planning and discuss the Children's progress.

Moulton Preschool is registered to accept 2 year old funded places as well as 3 & 4 year old funding.
